Volunteer Drop-off Team Leader

Reports to Logistics Coordinator or Regional Point of Contact

Summary

Develop and lead a team of Collection Network volunteers to share the hope of Jesus Christ through Operation Christmas Child (OCC) by meeting the logistical needs of collecting shoebox gifts at the Drop-off location.

Primary Responsibilities

- Recruit an interdenominational team of qualified volunteers to ensure that the Drop-off location is supported properly with the purpose of increasing OCC's capacity to collect shoebox gifts
- Provide spiritual leadership and team goals for Collection Network volunteers
- Communicate consistently with the Logistics Coordinator
- Submit an accurate Profile and Agreement by the deadline given
- Equip Collection Network volunteers to ensure that accurate and legible shoebox participation log sheets are completed at each Drop-off location during NCW
- Secure transportation to ship all shoebox gifts to designated Central Drop-off location on schedule

Qualifications

Spiritually mature Christian with strong interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills. Must be connected to and knowledgeable of their designated geographic area and be committed to the ministry goals of SP/OCC. **Regular access to an individual email account and MyOCC is required.**

Training Expectations

- Participate in initial online training
- Participate in Annual and Ministry Specific Training
- Attend Area Team meetings (encouraged)
- Attend Connect Conferences (encouraged)

Volunteer Time Commitment

- One year, may hold ministry position for multiple terms. Term may be ended at any time by volunteer or OCC Regional Staff
- Time commitment of 2 to 5 hours per month, may increase to 5 to 10 hours during October and November. Will likely increase to 15 or more hours during National Collection Week.

Samaritan's Purse Statement of Faith

- We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God. *1 Thessalonians 2:13; 2 Timothy 3:15-17.*
- We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. *Matthew 28:19; John 10:30; Ephesians 4:4-6.*
- We believe in the deity of the Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His miracles, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood on the cross, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory. *Matthew 1:23; John 1:1-4 and 1:29; Acts 1:11 and 2:22-24; Romans 8:34; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4; 2 Corinthians 5:21; Philippians 2:5-11; Hebrews 1:1-4 and 4:15.*
- We believe that all men everywhere are lost and face the judgment of God, that Jesus Christ is the only way of salvation, and that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, repentance of sin and faith in Jesus Christ results in regeneration by the Holy Spirit. *Luke 24:46-47; John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Romans 3:23; 2 Corinthians 5:10-11; Ephesians 1:7 and 2:8-9; Titus 3:4-7.*
- We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, whose indwelling enables the Christian to live a godly life. *John 3:5-8; Acts 1:8 and 4:31; Romans 8:9; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Galatians 5:16-18; Ephesians 6:12; Colossians 2:6-10.*
- We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; the saved unto the resurrection of eternal life and the lost unto the resurrection of damnation and eternal punishment. *1 Corinthians 15:51-57; Revelation 20:11-15.*
- We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ and that all true believers are members of His body, the church. *1 Corinthians 12:12, 27; Ephesians 1:22-23.*
- We believe that the ministry of evangelism and discipleship is a responsibility of all followers of Jesus Christ. *Matthew 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:9-15; 1 Peter 3:15.*
- We believe God's plan for human sexuality is to be expressed only within the context of marriage, that God created man and woman as unique biological persons made to complete each other. God instituted monogamous marriage between male and female as the foundation of the family and the basic structure of human society. For this reason, we believe that marriage is exclusively the union of one genetic male and one genetic female. *Genesis 2:24; Matthew 19:5-6; Mark 10:6-9; Romans 1:26-27; 1 Corinthians 6:9.*
- We believe that we must dedicate ourselves to prayer, to the service of our Lord, to His authority over our lives, and to the ministry of evangelism. *Matthew 9:35-38; 22:37-39, and 28:18-20; Acts 1:8; Romans 10:9-15 and 12:20-21; Galatians 6:10; Colossians 2:6-10; 1 Peter 3:15.*
- We believe that human life is sacred from conception to its natural end; and that we must have concern for the physical and spiritual needs of our fellowmen. *Psalms 139:13; Isaiah 49:1; Jeremiah 1:5; Matthew 22:37-39; Romans 12:20-21; Galatians 6:10.*

Volunteer Waiver

Samaritan's Purse Authorization and Release



By participating in Samaritan's Purse activities, I understand and agree with the following statements:

- I assume all risks associated with Samaritan's Purse/Operation Christmas Child activities and release Samaritan's Purse (SP) from any and all liability for claims or damages I might have that result from volunteering with SP. I understand that SP is not responsible for the safety or security of my personal effects and release SP from liability for theft, damage or destruction of my personal property.
- I understand and acknowledge that I am a volunteer, not an employee of SP or other organizations that SP works with. As a volunteer, I am not entitled to employee or other benefits from SP such as health or accident insurance, workers compensation benefits, or compensation for duties performed or hours worked.
- I consent to allowing SP to contact emergency medical care or first aid in the event I suffer any illness or accident while performing volunteer activities. I release, discharge and hold SP harmless from any claim related to the provision of such emergency medical care.
- I understand that SP/OCC strives to be good stewards of their resources and diligent in their concern for the safety and security of all volunteers, staff, and resources affiliated with the ministry. Therefore, I acknowledge that if I have been convicted of crimes against minors or sexual offenses, I am prohibited from volunteering at Operation Christmas Child related events and activities.
- I acknowledge and agree that while volunteering with SP, my activities may be photographed or videotaped. I consent to the use by SP and/or its authorized representative of photographs or videos in which I appear, and I acknowledge and agree that I have no ownership rights in or to those photographs or videos. I release SP, its agents and assignees from any claims that I may have relating to any photographs or videos, including without limitation, and claim arising under the right of publicity, right or privacy, defamation and/or copyright infringement.
- I understand that certain travel, meals and lodging may be deductible related to my volunteer activities as a charitable contribution. I understand that I have been advised to consult my tax advisor regarding charitable contribution deductions and any other tax questions.
